- 13:00 - Students make their way to their third business and take part in a short activity
- 13:15 - Students are free to speak to any business they like for the next 15 minutes
- 13:30 - Progression presentation including apprenticeships and next steps
- 14:00 - Students leave and make their way back to school

The morning and afternoon sessions will consist of 150 students aged 15+ which will be broken down into groups of 25. These groups will rotate round the 6 businesses that will be present.

To enable all students to have the same opportunity to speak to all businesses, we are allowing them 15 minutes of free time to speak to whoever they want.

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
